The Program

The curriculum for the online degree is the same as for the on-campus degree. Only the delivery is changed. All course descriptions remain the same and, in most cases, the course will be taught by the same professors who teach on campus.

Courses that require classroom work or job placements, such as some science classes, physical education, business work experience, and classroom observations and student teaching will require special arrangements that include organizations in your local community. Each will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

When a course is not available online through North Carolina A&T State University, you will be assisted in finding a comparable course at another state university or at a local community college (if the course is at the freshman or sophomore level). Only accredited institutions will be used, and proper approvals must be received before the class is taken.

The University

North Carolina A&T State University is one of the constituent institutions of the University of North Carolina system. The University is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Department of Business Education is accredited by the AACSB International -- The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (as part of the School of Business and Economics) as well as by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE).

Licensure Exam

The licensure exam for business teachers is the PRAXIS II – Business Education. The state of North Carolina requires that candidates pass the exam to receive a license to teach in NC public schools. Assistance is provided in preparing for the exam. Our 96% pass rate over the past seven years suggest that we are doing a good job.

Job Placement

Our program has a 100% success rate placing its graduates in business teaching positions. Many have also gone on to teach graduate programs.

Field Experiences

At least three courses require field experiences in which you will be expected to spend between 20 and 60 credits hours in a business education classroom. These are CUIN 301, CUIN 400, and BUED 675. You will also be required to complete a semester-long student teaching activity—CUIN 560.
