IT is a pleasure to have this opportunity to update you on The Jackson Scholarship Endowment. As of June 30, 2006, the endowment fund balance was **\$104,589.00** (*corpus and interest*). The amount allocated for spending from the fund for 2006-2007 was **\$4,800**.

The most recent recipient of the Jackson Foundation Endowed Scholarships is Ms. Sara Marie Gibson. She is a sophomore, Nursing major with a 3.170 and a single mother of one (*boy*).

The recipients of the 2004-05 Jackson Foundation Endowed Scholarships are Ms. Kimberly L. Wright and Ms. Kenetta N. Kelly. Ms. Kelly is an incoming freshman from West Hempstead, NY with a grade point average of 3.8 on a four point scale majoring in Nursing. She was awarded \$2,300. Ms. Wright is a sophomore Engineering major from Augusta Georgia. Maintaining a 3.903 GPA on a four-point scale, she was awarded \$1,500.

Prior year recipient of the Jackson Foundation Endowed Scholarship was Mr. Clifton Neal, a junior in the College of Arts & Sciences from Richmond Virginia with a GPA of 2.98. He has received from the endowment \$2,200.
