Dear Dr. Renick:

At its June 2004 meeting, the Commission on Accreditation (Commission) reviewed materials submitted by the baccalaureate social work degree program at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University in support of the request for restoration to full-accredited status. It is my pleasure to inform you that the Commission voted to restore the program to full-accredited status. This action, in combination with the Commission review of the program in June 2002 for reaffirmation of accredited status, means that the program is now accredited through June 2010.

The Commission appreciates and affirms the many strengths in the program, and commends the efforts of the faculty and others associated with achieving restoration. The Commission noted that the program submitted documentation of corrective action taken to address two areas of noncompliance. The program demonstrated, in meeting with the Committee, how its outcome measures and measurement procedures directly assess the extent to which students are attaining the program objectives.

However, the Commission identified one area of continuing concern in the area of program assessment and continuous improvement, discussed below, and requests three copies of a Progress Report on this concern by April 1, 2005 to be reviewed by the Commission at its meeting in June 2005.


**Accreditation Standard 8.1:** The program implements its plan to evaluate the outcome of each program objective and shows evidence that the analysis is used continuously to affirm and improve the educational program. *The program needs to show evidence that the results of evaluation influence program planning and curriculum design – explain how the evaluative findings are integrated into the program and curriculum design – and describe the structure through which evaluative findings are integrated into the program.*
