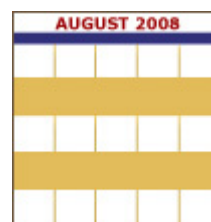
For the first time at A&T, 15% of the freshman class is under age 18.

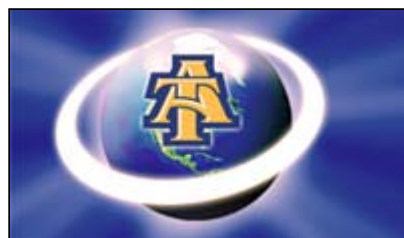
