

6. Continuing Education and Employment

The following is a sample listing of how students from the program are engaged after graduation. Over the past five years 29% of graduates have entered either medical school, veterinary medical school or a Ph.D. program. Thirty-five percent have entered MS programs. Thus 60% of graduates pursue graduate training. The remainder are engaged in a variety of Animal Health related careers in either industry or government service.
