Locations and Distance Education

Presently, there are a number of distance learning extension courses and programs offered at four (4) sites throughout North Carolina. These sites include: (1) Randolph County Schools - New Market Elementary - Sophia, NC (MAED Elementary Education and MAED Reading Education), (2) Rockingham County Schools – Bethany Elementary School – Reidsville, NC (MAED-Reading Education), (3) Winston Salem/Forsyth County Schools – Union Cross Elementary – Kernersville, NC, (MAED – Elementary Education), and (4) Winston-Salem, NC (M.S. – School Administration).

Currently, there are over 550 online courses developed and offered in all colleges and schools at NCA&TSU. These courses are distributed in the School of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences, College of Arts and Sciences, School of Business and Economics, School of Education, College of Engineering, School of Nursing, School of Technology, and University Studies. To date, there are five Bachelor of Science online degree programs: (1) Agricultural Education, (2) Business Education, (3) Electronics Technology, (4) Occupational Safety and Health, and (5) Technology Education. There are four online Master of Science degree programs: (1) Agricultural Education, (2) Information Technology, (3) Instructional Technology and (4) Technology Education. NCA&TSU is also a consortium member with Indiana State University to offer the online Ph.D. program in Technology Management. Students from North Carolina and throughout the United States enroll in online courses and programs. Additionally, CDL is a key participant in the ServiceMembers Opportunity Colleges (SOC) program, which enables military students from around the world to complete their degree while they are serving our country.
