**Department/Program Overview:**

North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University invites applications and nominations for the position of Director of Athletics. The University is one of 16 institutions of The University of North Carolina and is a public, comprehensive institution granting undergraduate, graduate and doctoral degrees. Academic programs are offered through the Schools of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences, Business and Economics, Education, Nursing, Technology, Graduate Studies, and the Colleges of Engineering and Arts and Sciences. North Carolina A&T State University is a member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), an association of eleven premier colleges and universities committed to excellence in academics and athletics. The Director will lead an intercollegiate athletic program for men and women, including basketball, baseball, football, bowling, softball, swimming, tennis, track and field, and volleyball. The men's and women's programs compete at the Division I level with football competing at the Division I-AA level.

**Primary Duties and Responsibilities:**

The Director of Athletics will be responsible for the leadership and operation of a comprehensive NCAA Division I Program. He/she must be committed to maintaining the highest level of excellence, the integration of the academic and athletic experience for students and the potential for athletics to enrich the experience of all students at the University. He/she will be responsible for the quality and integrity of all athletic programs, program promotion and fundraising, the management of fiscal and human resources, and athletic facilities. The Director will report directly to the Office of the Chancellor to assure success.

**Qualifications:**

The successful candidate must provide outstanding leadership; collaborate with faculty, staff and students; and develop strong relationships with alumni and other constituents of the University. The candidate must have demonstrated successful experience in fundraising, administering athletic programs, managing an effective marketing program, developing positive relationships with the community and media, and commitment to and support of NCAA guidelines inclusive of Title IX and diversity. Outstanding interpersonal written and oral communication skills are essential. Experience should include a minimum of 10 years of progressively increasing management and leadership at a Division I institution. A Bachelor's degree is required and coaching experience is preferred.
