The University

North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University invites applications and nominations for the position of Vice Chancellor for Development and University Relations. The University is one of 16 institutions of The University of North Carolina and is a public, comprehensive institution granting undergraduate, graduate and doctoral degrees. Academic programs are offered through the Schools of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences, Business and Economics, Education, Nursing, Technology, Graduate Studies, and the Colleges of Engineering and Arts and Sciences. Development and University Relations

The Division of Development and University Relations is the University's arm for institutional advancement. The Vice Chancellor for Development and University Relations reports directly to the Chancellor and is responsible for fundraising through annual, corporate, planned and major gift programs; alumni cultivation and services for approximately 33,000 graduates; public relations through local, state and national affairs as well as marketing, news services and photo-video communications. The Vice Chancellor develops and administers processes for strategic advancement planning, prospect management, volunteer relations and support; interacts with members of the Board of Trustees through the Chancellor and oversees communications related to the corporate and foundation relations programs. The Vice Chancellor serves as the Executive Director for the University Foundation, a non-profit corporation designed to receive and administer funds from the private sector, and performs other related duties as assigned by the Chancellor, including coordination of the University Cluster activities.

Qualifications

North Carolina A&T State University is seeking applicants with an earned MBA/Ph.D./BS degrees or equivalent senior-level leadership experience. The nominees should bring effective management, dynamic leadership, creative thinking and enthusiasm for excellence to a maturing environment and administrative team eager to expand the base and level of support for the University's continued success. The ideal candidate will possess the following qualification; Extensive successful and diverse fund-raising experience, including planning and implementing a successful capital campaign, demonstrated success as a creative, collaborative, and effective manager; experience in an academic environment, preferably in a research university, demonstrated success in developing an effective volunteer structure; knowledge of local and national funding sources; ability and willingness to travel frequently; exceptional interpersonal and communication skills; supportive of the mission, philosophy, and values of North Carolina A&T State University.
