NCATE and TEAC Design Team at Work

The joint TEAC and NCATE design team is holding regular meetings to make some preliminary recommendations to the respective systems of accreditation that will encourage all the nation's educators to achieve national accreditation. The new system will strengthen and improve accreditation in education and will offer the nation's schools a choice of TEAC and NCATE approaches to accreditation as they exist now and will be improved in the future. In January, 2009, TEAC and NCATE issued a joint statement titled 'Towards a Unified Accreditation System for Educator Preparation.'
