UNC Tomorrow Commission Charge

The University of North Carolina Tomorrow Commission was charged with the important task of guiding the University's initiative to determine how UNC can best meet the needs of North Carolina and its people both now and into the future. The Commission, a blue-ribbon group including business, education, government, and nonprofit leaders from across the state, was charged with learning what the people of North Carolina need from their University and making recommendations to the Board of Governors on what needs UNC should respond to.

During the course of the initiative, Commission members and staff:

- Assessed current and future challenges facing North Carolina over the next 20 years;
- Traveled the state visiting UNC campuses, meeting with regional leaders in different sectors and industries, and listening to the public express their concerns and needs in the face of the evolving challenges facing North Carolina;
- Identified potential responses UNC might make to those challenges; and
- Helped devise a long-term plan that will position UNC to remain demand-driven, proactive, and responsive consistent with the University's mission of teaching, research, and public service.

Tomorrow Commission Named

In the spring of 2007, the UNC Board of Governors launched UNC Tomorrow, an initiative to determine how the University of North Carolina can best meet the needs of the state and its people.
